2007 Pinot Gris Brand, Domaine Albert Boxler <i>The fragrant bouquet of the wine is very rich, with bright notes of ripe peach, white plum, lychee and oriental spices. Well-structured wine, juicy, full, with a well-defined acidity and fruity after-taste. Aging has given it a glorious deep colour</i>	-	£100.00
2004 Riesling Grand Cru Brand, Domaine Albert Boxler <i>A beautiful golden and clear hue, intense and brilliant, promising a high-level tasting which the first scents quickly confirm. The nose demonstrates a complex, chiselled, refined and feminine wine: the Riesling is there, certainly, but with candied pineapple, white flowers and amber. On the palate, it presents a soft attack without any heaviness because relayed by a subtle acidity and a stony mineral. Wonderful wine</i>	-	£100.00
2001 Pinot Gris Dorfbrg, Meyer-Fonné <i>Smells like honey liquor but it's not nearly that sweet on the palate.
